

Snail trail instructions

- With one note – I increased the size of the squares to cut by $1/8$ " so we wouldn't have to cut squares that were $X-7/8$ "
- Trim to size after each round

Fabric Cutting Directions:

Before starting to make the block, cut the following from **EACH of your two fabrics:**

Fabric pieces for 12 x 12 inch finished size

- 2, 2" X 2" squares
- 1, 3" X 3" square
- 1, $3\ 7/8$ " X 4" square
- 1, $5\ 1/8$ " X 5.5" square
- 1, $6\ 7/8$ X 7" square

12 $1/2$ X 12 $1/2$ inches unfinished size

The outside corners of the triangles will extend slightly beyond the outside edges of the Four-Patch unit. Trim after each round.

Use a 1/4-inch seam allowance. I recommend using a special presser foot with a 1/4-inch guide if you have one for your machine. This will help you get uniform seams, and matching seams.

Right Sides Together. Sew fabric together with right sides together. Unless otherwise noted.
